CEJA Provisions on Electrification as Electric Efficiency

- Electrification can count towards electric utility kWh savings goals
 - 2022-2025: up to 5% of annual savings goals
 - 2026-2029: up to 10% of annual savings goals
 - After 2029: up to 15% of annual savings goals
- Electrification “savings” based on reductions in site BTUs
- Only electrification from buildings (no cars/EVs)
- 25% of electrification savings must come from low-income customers
- Utilities must provide customers estimates of energy bill impacts
