

Dane County, WI

- State capital (Madison)
- UW- Madison, Big 10 university
- 550K residents
- Fastest growing county in Wisconsin
- 55k cows (mostly dairy)
- 3 IOUs plus munis and coops
- Resource rich, progressively minded
- 70% worry about global warming (Wisconsin 52%; US 62%)
- Significant racial disparities

2012: Greening county ops

2017: Office of Energy & Climate Change

Council on Climate Change

2020: Climate Action Plan

2023: 100% clean electricity county ops

2030: Cut countywide emissions 50%

 - Dairy digesters reduce phosphorous in lakes




Mobilizing Local Governments
