- What was the goal of midstream?
 - Making it easier for DTE customer to participate in Energy Efficiency Programs
 - Targeting small and mid-size customers
 - Easy accessibility for customers
 - Not customer application required
 - Instant rebate at point of purchase, no wait time
 - Clear pre-set rebate amounts

 - ASK, ASK, ASK!
- Market studies
 - Know what has the most potential in your market
- Know your local market
 - Who are key distributors and manufactures?
 - Who can you turn to for questions?
 - Know what your talking about
- Look downstream
 - Where are the gaps?
 - Is it applicable to a midstream model?

- Control Growth
 - Signup windows
 - Introductory budgets
 - Slowly add new products
- Round Table Events
 - Satisfaction and ease of program
 - Ideas for growth
- Flexibility
 - How rebates are set up?
 - How do you do outreach?
- Creativity!
 - Virtual verification
 - Create competition among distributors





Success

Midstream Lighting

- More than **1.7 million** LED lamps, fixtures and occupancy sensors rebated from October 2015 through November 2020
- 35+ distributors participate in the program

Midstream Food Service

- In 2020 alone, **709 units** of food service equipment have been incentivized through the program
- 26 local and national Dealers/Consultants are part of the FS program

Midstream HVAC

- More than 1,700 units processed since the start of the program in June 2018
- 25+ local and national distributors representing both electric and gas equipment manufacturers
